



# SYH CLASSIC REGATTA 2022

## *SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS*



These supplementary instructions should be read in conjunction with the main sailing instructions for the event, which apply where applicable. They apply for an informal/tune-up race prior to the main regatta.

### 1. SCHEDULE

The race will begin at 1800 on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

### 2. FLEETS

The fleets division employed in the main regatta will not be utilised. This race will be run as a single fleet.

### 3. CHECKING IN

Competitors will not find hailing the race officer simple so for this race checking in will be done via VHF Ch. 77. As boats approach the SYH fair water mark a radio call to the race office should be made stating the boat name and number of persons on board. This will be confirmed as understood.

### 4. START and FINISH LINE

All signals will be made over VHF Ch. 77 rather than by flags although there may be sound signals. The start and finish line is defined as: **A line drawn through the signals mast at the race officers building and a fore-mark with two triangles as top mark positioned on the up-river quay head of the SYH entrance**, and it will be crossed in the direction as direct from the race hut.

NOTE: There are two lights above the race building and the lower will extinguish as the viewer transits the line.

### 5. COURSE

The course will broadcast a number of times over VHF Ch. 77 and will be made up of the fixed buoys in the vicinity of SYH. There is a diagram/chart supplied with main Sailing Instructions that will show these. It should be noted that when passing the SYH fair water mark it should be left to the North, i.e. you are to the South of it.

### 6. TIME LIMITS

The time limits in the main Sailing Instructions will not apply. This race being early evening will be managed from the HPYC race hut and will be shortened via VHF Ch. 77 to enable participants to enjoy other aspects of the evening.
