MOTORBOAT INSTRUCTIONS

- All instructions on the water for motorboats will be on VHF channel TBC (which will be confirmed before or at the briefing on the day) in conjunction with the Classic Regatta WhatsApp group
- Motorboats to be berthed in front of LV87 Haven Ports Yacht Club lightship
- Briefing will take place on the pontoon at 11am on 11th June
- Motorboats to leave SYH at 11:30 and head for Dovercourt Bay
- All Faireys to fly the Fairey Club Burgee
- Motorboats are to set out on a parade of power from a standing start off the committee boat line with a course set out on the day
- The start of the parade will be denoted by a gun fired from the committee boat between five and ten minutes after the last sailing boat has finished the first race
- Classic sailing yachts are invited to watch the start of the motorboat parade of power
- The cruising speed will be set at the briefing
- On the water photographers will be capturing the parade on camera and video
- The course is envisaged to take approx. 20 minutes. Please feel free to safely move around within the fleet of motorboats to view others whilst underway
- Once over the finish line, motorboats are invited to view the afternoon's sailing yacht racing or join the motorboat fleet in Harwich for refreshments
- Motorboats to be berthed back at SYH by 16:00 when live music will start along with SYH complimentary chilled beers and gin and tonics, which will be available from the Harbour Room
- The Eastern Ports Fairey silver plate and the French Marine Motorboat trophy will be presented at the prize giving on Sunday
